EUGENE, Ore. – The Ford Family Foundation has selected 40 students as new recipients of the Ford Sons & Daughters Program for the 2020-2021 academic year.

Full-time students attending two-year colleges each receive \$3,000 annually, while full-time students attending four-year colleges or universities receive \$5,000 annually. Recipients, who must be age 21 or younger, are dependents of Roseburg Forest Products Co. employees.

The scholarship can be awarded to up to 10% of all eligible dependents, so the number of awardees varies each year.

The scholarship is renewable for up to four years and can be used for tuition, fees, books, personal expenses, and room and board.

Kenneth W. Ford and Hallie E. Ford built their company, Roseburg Forest Products Co., into one of the largest privately held companies in the United States. They established The Ford Family Foundation in 1957 after the business had experienced two decades of growth.

Other scholarships supported by the Foundation include the Ford Scholars Program, the Ford Transfer Scholars Program, the Ford Opportunity Scholars Program, and the Ford ReStart Scholars Program.

Since 1994, the Foundation's scholarship programs have awarded students more than \$200 million.
