This scholarship program serves the sons and daughters of employees of Roseburg Forest Products Co. to continue their education beyond high school. Each year, up to 10% of all eligible dependents are selected to receive a renewable Ford Sons & Daughters Scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

- Be a dependent child or stepchild of an employee of Roseburg Forest Products Co.** The employee must be full time and have been employed full time by Roseburg Forest Products Co. for a minimum of 18 months as of March 1 of the application year.
- Be 21 years old or younger** as of March 1 of the application year. If selected, recipients may continue in the scholarship program beyond age 21.
- Has a goal to achieve an associate, bachelor's, or technical degree** (and has not previously earned a bachelor's degree).
- Will attend full time, on campus,** at a Title IV eligible public or private, non-profit or for-profit postsecondary institution, beginning in fall of the application year. Online college education programs do not qualify.
- Has no felony convictions or has **satisfied the terms** of any felony conviction by August 1 of the application year.
- Applicants are encouraged to file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** as soon as possible after October 1, as they may be eligible for other forms of additional financial aid.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Successful candidates demonstrate:

- Initiative and commitment to success in school, and other activities.
- Outstanding character.
- A concern for others through volunteer service and/or help with family needs.
- Responsibility and a strong work ethic through paid and/or unpaid work experiences.
- An ability to clearly communicate their strengths and goals, both verbally and in writing.
- A well thought out education plan and ability to succeed academically.

SCHOLARSHIP EXPECTATIONS

Recipients will progress academically and communicate regularly with the Foundation Scholarship office. The scholarship is renewable each year if the recipient is in good standing.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

Scholarship award amounts for the Ford Sons & Daughters Program depend on the type of postsecondary institution the recipient is attending. A recipient enrolled in a 2-year college or program will receive an award amount of \$3,000 each academic year. A recipient enrolled in a 4-year college or program will receive an award amount of \$5,000 each academic year.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

All application materials must be submitted online by 5 p.m. PST on MARCH 1 of each year.
